  - a. Examine what constitutes a quality classroom environment.
  - b. Illustrate how children's learning is influenced by multiple contexts; including family, community and culture.
  - c. Explore the impact of the classroom environment on children's behavior

d. Implement Developmentally Appropriate classroom practices that create positive outcomes for children.
