## **Student Learning Outcomes & Enabling Objectives**

- 1. Analyze components of revenue cycle management and clinical documentation improvement. (IV.2, IV.3)(Bloom's 4)
  - a. Examine payment methodologies and systems including capitation, Prospective Payment Systems (PPS), Resource Based Relative Value Scale (RBRVS), case mix, MS-DRGs, healthcare insurance policies, and insurance claims (i.e. CMS-1500, UB-04).
  - b. Explore case management/coordinated care.
  - c. Summarize regulatory requirements and reimbursement methodologies.
- 2. Evaluate revenue cycle management processes, compliance with regulatory requirements and reimbursement methodologies. (IV.2.RM, IV.3.RM)(Bloom's 5)
  - Assess reimbursement processes and procedures (i.e. Case mix management, Discharged Not Final Billed, Chargemaster maintenance, Computer-assisted Coding, POA and HACs).
