 - b. Recognize the impact of self-awareness, personal feelings and values have on your interactions with clients.
- 9. Explore the scope of Intimate Partner Violence, the risk factors and trauma impact associated with Intimate Partner Violence.
 - a. Identify the different types of intimate partner violence and their scope.

- 10. Explore the abuse of the Elderly and the Disabled person, the risk factors and trauma influence.
 - a. Define the scope of impact of abuse of the elderly.
 - b. Explore the potential consequences of abuse of the elderly.
 - c. Describe treatment alternatives for abuse.
- 11. Identify and explore the Impact of societal themes on family violence.
 - a. Explain how each societal theme impacts family violence.
