 - e. Identify the learning needs of patients in a health care environment.

 - e. Access current, professional, and evidence-based health care information that supports nursing interventions.
 - f. Demonstrate the use of effective therapeutic communication techniques.
 - g. Correlate the concepts of QSEN to basic nursing skills and provision of nursing care.
 - h. Identify the essential knowledge, skills, and attitudes (KSAs) to provide safe, quality patient care.
- 3. Apply principles of professional nursing practice as a healthcare team member in the provision of patient care.
 - a. Apply Jean Watson's Caritas Processes as they relate to nursing practice.
 - b. Examine cultural considerations in the development of the patient's plan of care.
 - c. Practice effective communication techniques with patients, families, members of the interdisciplinary team, faculty, and peers.

- d. Describe roles of various members of the healthcare team.
- e. Describe the process of collaboration in the health care setting.
- f. Exhibit professional behaviors.
- g. Practice essential KSAs in the provision of safe, quality patient care.
