1. Plan care based on the needs of the older adult and/or the chronically ill and associated support systems.
 - a. Describe the unique physiological, physical and psychosocial needs of the older adult and/or chronically ill (i.e. client).

 - f. Integrate cultural beliefs, values and preferences to meet the holistic needs of the older adult or chronically ill.

 - a. Employ effective communication strategies to meet the needs of the aging client or chronically ill individual.
 - b. Incorporate collaborative, multidisciplinary plans of care
 - c. Communicate appropriate patient information, according to facility policy and nursing standards, within the team.
3. Incorporate current, evidence based health and wellness information into the care of the client.
 - a. Analyze research information and utilize evidence when planning and providing care.
 - b. Demonstrate knowledge, skills, and abilities related to health information technologies, relevant to the care of the client.
 - c. Recognize pertinent diagnostic and laboratory findings and incorporate the information into the care of the client.
