3. Model leadership skills and decision making in the coordination of nursing care delivery for multiple, complex patients.
 - a. Prioritize patient needs appropriately.
 - b. Demonstrate the ability to appropriately and safely delegate patient care tasks.

- c. Apply leadership concepts in advocating for changes in systems that promote improved patient outcomes.
- d. Utilize a quality and safety framework to evaluate systems and processes that affect patient outcomes.
