Student Learning Outcomes and Enabling Objectives

- 1. Manage nursing care of adult patients with complex disease processes.

 - d. Differentiate the complexity of providing safe, quality care to meet the need of patients with complex disease processes across the continuum.
- 3. Model leadership skills and decision making in the coordination of nursing care delivery for multiple, complex patients.
 - a. Prioritize patient needs appropriately.
 - b. Demonstrate the ability to appropriately and safely delegate patient care tasks.

- c. Apply leadership concepts in advocating for changes in systems that promote improved patient outcomes.
- d. Utilize a quality and safety framework to evaluate systems and processes that affect patient outcomes.
