Baker College has programs that give high school students a **RunningStart** on their college education. High school students can earn college credit or an associate's degree, in most cases at no cost, while earning a high school diploma.

College courses at your HS, taught by a BC-vetted HS instructor.

Dual Enrollment

Join college students in college courses on campus or online.

EMC

Earn a certificate or associate's degree along with your HS diploma.

Accreditation

Baker College remains one of only two colleges in Michigan (and the only 4-year institution in Michigan) that is accredited by the National Alliance of Concurrent Enrollment Partnerships (NACEP).

RS has rolled out a comprehensive website that enables students to complete forms and counselors, students and advisors to obtain information about programs of study, transcripts, MTA course completions, expected graduation and more.

Value

Baker's Running Start Direct Credit program is one of the best values in Michigan: \$128 per credit hour with no added fees and one-on-one virtual tutoring available to every student. For Concurrent Enrollment, the cost is \$68 per credit hour.

Finances

Baker College Running Start Program is achieving additional financial accountability through the implementation of independent budgeting of revenues and costs.

Recruitment

Baker College Enrollment and Running Start have integrated and aligned recruitment strategies to ensure efficient registration and matriculation of students.

Professional Development

All Running Start faculty members, Direct Credit and Concurrent Enrollment, are now attending both Running Start Professional Development and Academic Orientation programs.

Books

Running Start book orders are now centralized through forms submitted to a main bookstore location, creating more efficiency and cost savings.

Virtual Delivery

Baker College faculty transitioned seamlessly to virtual delivery during the COVID-19 pandemic; they already knew how after years of online delivery. We have also developed a number of 16-week online course options for our Running Start students.
